BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Professor Jan I. Haaland was elected as Rector of the NHH Norwegian School of Economics in 2005, and is now in his second 4-year period. He has been President of the Norwegian Association of Higher Education Institutions (UHR) since August 2009, and he is member of the Council of the European University Association (EUA). He is also a member of the Strategic Board of CEMS – the global alliance in management education.

Jan I. Haaland received his Ph.D. from NHH in 1984, and he has been a professor of international economics at NHH since 1994. His main research areas are international trade, economic integration and general equilibrium modeling. He has been a research fellow at Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) in London since 1992. Over the years he has held many positions at NHH and in national and international networks.
